2. The Tribulation Martyrs in White Robes

(Jews and Gentiles under the altar)

Martyrs: Rev.6:9-11; Unmarked: 13:7,15; 15:2-4; 18:24; 19:2; Resurrected: 20:4b

3. The Saved Israelites & Gentiles

The 144,000 children of Israel from all the tribes (Rev.7:1-8) sealed to evangelize every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people (Rev.7:9-17; 14:1-5)

Two Witnesses Martyred: Rev.11:1-14; Angel preaching the Gospel: Rev.14:6,7

The plight of Israel during the Tribulation (Matt.24; Mk.13; Lk.21), redeemed by the blood, and protected from the dragon (Rev.ch.12), but many become martyrs (Rev.14:12,13; 17:6), the rest go before the Sheep & Goat Judgment (Zech.12:10-13:1,8,9; Matt.25:31-46) at the 2nd Coming:

The Millennial Kingdom

A literal 1000 yr. period (Rev.20:3-7), during which

Jesus Christ reigns on the earth in fulfillment of numerous prophecies: 2 Sam.7:12-16; Isa.2:2-4; 9:6,7; 11:1-12; 24:23; Isa.ch.35; 60; 62; 65:17-25; Hos.3:4,5; Joel 3:9-21; Amos 9:8-15; Mic.4:1-8; Eze.37:26-28; ch.40-48; Zeph.3:14-20; Zech.14:1-11; Jere.3:17,18; 23:5,6; Acts 15:16,17

4. The Unserved Judged (Goats)

- Jews & Gentiles who repented not (Rev.6:8,12-17; 9:14,15,20,21; 14:14-20; ch.16-18).
- The beast, the false prophet with all who receive the mark (Rev.14:9-11) and worship them are cast alive into a lake of fire at the 2nd Coming (19:11-21).
- The dragon or Satan bound for a thousand years to deceive the nations no more (Rev.20:2,3), then released after the millennium to continue his deception (vs.7-9), only to be cast into the lake of fire with the beast and the false prophet (Rev.20:10).
- White Throne Judgment: The dead (Rev.20:5a) cast into the lake of fire (vs.11-14).

First Coming

Daniel 9:24

1. Finish Israel's transgression of apostasy, 9:2.
2. Make an end of sins. Judge with finality, Heb.9:26.
3. Make reconciliation for iniquity, full atonement in Christ, Zech.13:1.

Romans 11:25-27

Daniel 9:27

Second Coming

4. Bring in righteousness after years of apostasy.
5. Seal up vision, fulfilling Israel's nation blessing, Gen.17:8.
6. Anoint the Most Holy, end of Gentile Power, reign of Christ, and consecrate millennial temple, Eze.40-48.

445 B.C.

1**Seventy weeks are determined for your people [Israel] and for your holy city [Jerusalem], To finish the transgression, To make an end of sins, To make reconciliation for iniquity, To bring in everlasting righteousness, To seal up vision and prophecy, and To anoint the Most Holy.
 2*Know therefore and understand that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince [Jesus Christ], there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks. The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times.
 3*And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself [for us]; And the people [Roman] of the prince [satanic] who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary [Titus, 70 A.D.]. The end of it shall be with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined. 4*Then he [Antichrist] shall confirm a covenant with many [Israel] for one week [70th week]; But in the middle of the week he [Antichrist] shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate."

Daniel Reveals Rich Prayer Instruction before his Angelic Visitation

TRUE PRAYER:

1. Is in response to the Word (9:2).
2. Is characterized by fervency & self-denial (9:3).
3. Identified unselfishly with God's people (9:5).
4. Strengthened by confession (9:5-15).
5. Dependent on God's character (9:4,7,9,15).
6. Has as its goal, God's glory (9:16-19).

7 weeks (49 yrs) plus 62 weeks (434 yrs) = 69 weeks (483 yrs)

Closing Nehemiah's rebuilding of the "street and wall," as well as end of Malachi and close of the Old Testament.

Daniel 9:25

434 more years to the first advent of Messiah, or the triumphal entry of Christ. Messiah "cut off" (9:26).

March 14th 445 B.C.

April 6th 32 A.D.

Captivity 70 yrs. x 7 (Israel's punishment, Lev.26:18,21) = 490 yrs.
 Jeremiah prophesied (25:11,12;29:10), captivity to restore Sabbath rest (2 Chr.36:20,21).

Space of almost 2000 yrs. awaiting the Rapture (Rev.ch. 4 & 5), Tribulation, Antichrist (Rev.6:2), and 144,000 Jewish witnesses (Rev.ch.7).
